
JUDGMENT

IT IS ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that the Motion for an *ex parte* Temporary Restraining Order is denied because petitioners have failed to provide written certification of attempts to notify opponent(s) that this petition was being filed, as required by La. Code Civ. Proc. art. 3603 A(2), and have failed to set forth facts in a verified petition or by supporting affidavit which would clearly establish that immediate and irreparable injury, loss or damage will result if a contradictory hearing is held after the bid process is begun but before title to any property is transferred, as required by La. Code Civ. Proc. art. 3603 A(1);

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that the defendants herein are to appear and show cause on the 17th day of December 2009, at 9:30 o'clock a.m. at 301 Main Street, Belle Chasse, LA why the Plaintiffs' Petition for a Preliminary Injunction should not be granted.
